

LANGUAGE OBJECTIVES– 6 TYPES

Key Vocabulary—The technical terms, concept words, and other words needed to discuss read, or write about the lesson topic

Example: I will define the terms chemical reaction and reagent.

Language Functions—The way students use language in the lesson (academic functions-describe, summarize, etc.)

Example: I will be able to write questions and generate hypotheses before conducting an experiment.

Language skills—Reading, writing, listening, and speaking skills students need to learn.

Example: I will be able to draft a lab report.

Grammar or Language Structures— Structures that need to be taught as they are prevalent in the written or spoken discourse of the class

Example: I will be able to use adverbs of time in my lab report.

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
